

Thank you again from Kevin and Lisa Lewis in Tucson AZ. Thank you for so many years of supporting us in serving our Lord. Like the rest of the world, this past year for us has presented challenges that we have never faced.

In this past year, I Kevin have taken on a role of supervisor with Missions Door in the Arizona region which includes two missionaries in Nevada and one in New Mexico. I have really enjoyed getting to know other missionaries, and seeing them get to know each other. This opportunity has opened doors to help and support other ministry focuses.

As I got to know one of our Navajo brothers who ministers on the reservation, he asked me to teach the book of Titus for him in a leadership training that he is running. Right now he is doing everything online so I taught from my office on Zoom for four Tuesdays in February.

These new relationships with other missionaries have given me the opportunity to come along side and give input to a couple individuals that are facing opposition among people where they work. A couple of these conversations were a bit difficult as the opposition was coming from people either in a church or related to some other Christian ministry. Our need as believers to be alert to deception and worldliness these day needs to be strengthened as our society continues to reject our God and His word.

In the month of March I got a special opportunity to go the Mexico for two weeks to teach a course in Spanish that both Lisa and I love to teach, "Firm Foundations, Creation to Christ". The time there was better than I could have imagined, I was with a really good group of students open to learn and serve our Lord.

Lisa continues to battle through this year teaching for a Christian school nearby. The struggle to teach online has been tremendous throughout this school year and fortunately the plan is to go back to in person classes next year. She has such an awesome heart to teach and influence the kids for Christ. She is also teaching that same course for her bible class there that I taught in Mexico, but in English.

We continue to look to the Lord for whatever might be in our future. In another letter I mentioned that our support level is not what it used to be, and ministry in the US is definitely changing. Please be praying with us as to what the Lord wants to do as we consider these things. We know we will serve Him no matter what, even if these days bring change as to how we go about that. Changes are hard, especially when you are over 30 like us. Nevertheless, God is sovereign and we can trust Him as we walk by faith.
