From the Harris Family

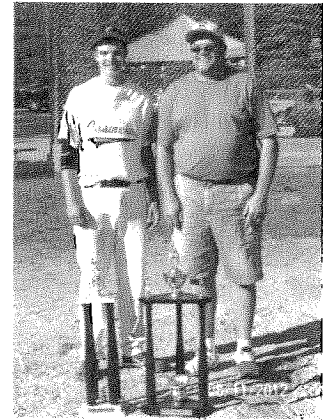
