In the spring of 1942 Paul Fleming, Cecil Dye, Bob Williams, and Lance Latham signed a basic agreement that would become New Tribes Mission. July 17, 1942 marked the first official meeting of the Executive Committee. On August 1st of that year Paul Fleming, Cecil Dye, and Bob Williams signed the pledge and covenant which formed the mission. In all of the discussion the main thrust was to reach those who had no opportunity to understand the gospel. With that same heart to reach the unreached, New Tribes Mission has changed to a new name which will further that end. It is exciting to be a part of what the Lord is doing as we represent Ethnos360. This change will enable us to reach into more parts of the world that are without the gospel.

An additional change occurred on May 4, 2017 with Ethnos360 being accepted into the fellowship of the IFCA (Independent Fundamental Churches of America International) Since 1930 the association has stood on the fundamental teaching of God's word as held historically(Look at the IFCA web site for additional information). We were privileged to represent the mission at their annual international conference.
