On Sunday, Nov 24th, Larry departed after receiving a call asking him to lend a helping hand in the city of Puerto Princesa, Philippines. He assisted by performing two 100hr. inspections for the aircraft supporting the pertinent relief efforts to supply food and basic supplies to suffering people due to sustained damages from the 'Typhoon Haiyan'.

In some cases the people were left with only the clothes on their backs and whatever they had in their hands, as the tidal surge and winds washed everything else out to sea. So it has been difficult for them to
