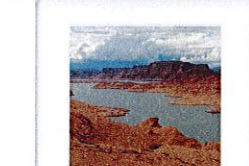
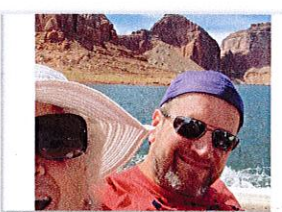
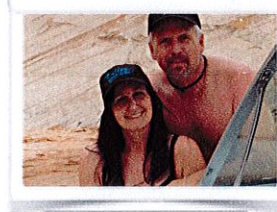
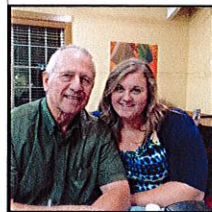
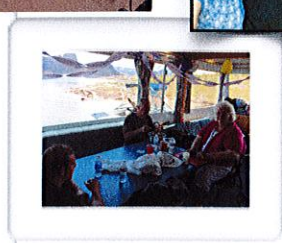


FALL NEWS FROM PAUL & PAT DYE-September-2015
