We want you to rejoice with us as we remember 31 years ago this month, when Paul was taken captive by the FARC(communist group) and held almost 5 days. He spent 4 difficult days in a prison camp in the deep jungles of Colombia...but God!
On the 5th in early morning...God got my husband out of the hands of the enemy and helped him fly the 185 Cessna that he used to fly into their camp days before with guerrillas sitting inside the cockpit and cab of the plane. Recently...The news media has talked about the peace talks that fell through with this group..They were never faithful to their word.

It was a happy, indescribable moment when Paul flew back to our mission base alive and well, looking a bit scrubby but we accepted that with joy! We continue to share the story about a Great God who delivered Paul out of the den of lions way back in October of 1985! For you that prayed way back then and continue to pray...we thank you and thank God for you!! It was our powerful God that helped him escape!

Paul will be celebrating his 76th birthday the end of this month and will finally reach his old wife's age! We are grateful that we still have each other and are able to enjoy life together. We feel so blessed!

Paul continues to work over at the hangar as Larry is his boss now (the rolls do change as we get older :)) and does many sewing jobs at home. He has helped the widows of the church as well and it's a ministry that could continue til he dies :) We continue to go to prison every Sunday together and thank God for the liberty and open doors still allowed to us! He goes every first and second Saturday and Sunday to the larger prison units as well! It could be up to 16 hours a month that he spends imprisoned :) Many have left as free men and are doing well and that blesses us indeed!

I am still recovering from my knee surgery done July 12th. Saw the Dr. last week and said I don't have to come back til next year and all was well!. But now the other knee has gone bad and it has made it hard to get up alone:(I look forward to Heaven and my new glorified body, how about you? Paul has been such a good nurse and helper. I am blessed indeed!

We do want to thank you for standing by us all of these years. As I write this I wish I could give you a big hug of love and appreciation...Did you get it?
God bless and keep you all well and safe...Rejoice with me that I have my husband... today...because of God's Great power!!!
