We serve a God that nothing surprises. He has planned each step and circumstances in our lives to help us grow stronger in our TRUST in Him.

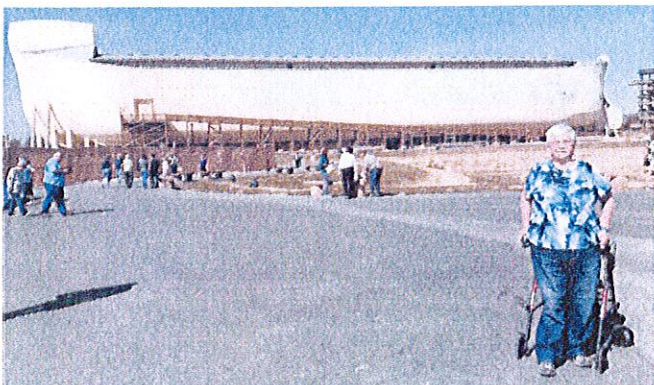
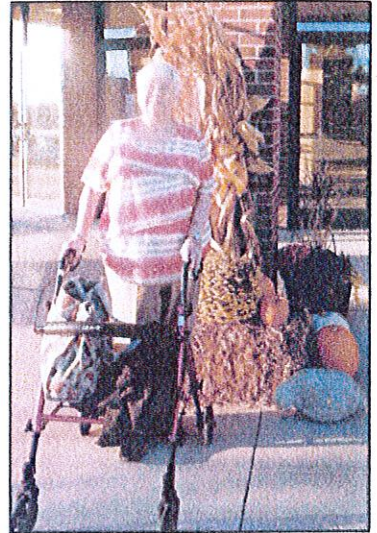
