Regarding items needed.

In addition to this, would include swim clothes and sleep outfits. We already have outfits for Daniel and Matthew all set as all of Michael's clothes can be re-used and are already there. ☺

Michael however, is growing like a weed! He is not even 10 yrs old yet and is already wearing 12/14 husky pants and 10/12 & 12/14 Youth M and L t-shirts. He will be a bit more tricky for us to estimate for...I am hoping to find some good end of summer sales as well as the Once Upon A Child, Salvation Army Family Stores and Good Will stores to get the majority of what we will need. We will be sending as much as we can over on a crate ahead of us. Michael will be 15 when we come back the next time ☹. So we are needing to plan for his pre-teen and teen years this term. CRAZY!!!

As far as Krystiana's clothing...We are planning for age/sizes 18mos thru size 5/6. Our weather ranges from the low 60's at night to the high 80's/90's during the day. We live in the mountains in the rain forest so it rains a lot.

USA→Right Now: We could use some 6-9 & 12 mos. Winterish clothing. We are all set with sleepers at this stage. Sweaters, L.S. shirt & pant outfits, tights etc...

PNG→Every day Wear:

Tops: Longer style tops, shorts, skirts and summer dresses. (Please no onsie style after 18months. ☺)

We need lots of the little shorts, or legging pants for under all skirts, dresses for modesty and protection. So these in various colors and sizes would be great.

Swim Wear:

Swimsuits with board shorts or swim skirts that can go over top to cover the knees are appropriate there. (1 set in each size)

Warm Wear / Rain Wear: (We live in the rainforest so the kids love to play outside in the rain.)

Sweater/Sweatshirt/hoodie zipper jacket / rain coat for different sizes 1-2 of each size, only 1 rain coat for each size would be necessary. 😊

Long sleeve shirts and long pants are Great!!! Especially for cold mornings and evenings. (2-3 of each of these in the various sizes)

PJ's:

Footy Pajamas are AWESOME! (1-2 of each size 18mnths to size 6)

Shoes:

Cute slip on shoes like the crocs, flip flops, sandals that can be easy to slip on and off and are more durable or washable. Rain boots. 😊 (no leather please)

Diapers:

We are planning to do as much cloth diapers as we can while we are state-side and will use cloth diapers fully overseas. However, at this time we will use disposable diapers while we travel and until she gets just a bit older/regulated. So some more size 1 and 2 (maybe up to 5 packs of each) and up to 3 packs of size 3.
