Last night, Robyn looked into the area where they were serving out all of our food, there were about 20 of our folks in there, some holding plates so the ladies could dish out the food, some holding lights so they could see, some taking food tickets, etc and all working together for the glory of God.



Our village folks also really helped us by telling people not to get drunk in our area during this time and therefore not bringing problems to the conference. The local 'cinema' (grass roofed house where people gather to watch very loud and usually very bad movies!) closed down

purposely during this time, and the owner allowed some of the visitors to sleep in his house, and other folks in the village offered their homes too.

The Bible teacher who got drunk, came back for the conference time and told us he knew he had done wrong and is planning to say sorry in front of the church on Sunday. Continue to pray for the other believers not to get pulled into drunkenness during politics.

The ditch at the bottom of the road is being filled in today, and cars to do with the conference had been allowed to come across on planks.

The truth has started to come out about Stephen, that he didn't have anything to do with injuring the man. This talk needs to come up to our area to get the people up here off his back, so pray for that to be settled.

The church group where the fighting and road blocks occurred, some of them were still able to come despite the danger to their lives. Due to the number of firearms in this area, believers are having to flee for their lives when the enemies arrive and the shooting starts. Please pray for peace in this area and that this wouldn't lead to the church being completely scattered.

Safe journeys were had by all, even though some arrived after dark.

Please pray for Jack, one of the Bible teachers for this time, who has got some flu-like symptoms and is feeling pretty rough right now (as was our co-worker Dan yesterday and some our boys)
