### **God's Word Going to a New Village...**

First, please pray for an outreach in the neighboring village that started last week. As we wrote in March, a young man named Walip became a believer just before to Christmas and died in March. His wish was for 'God's Talk' to be taught in his village. That door has remained open and last week the chronological teaching was started in Walip's village among his family members. There are about 12-15 people who attended the teaching last week. Our desire is that as word gets out more people will come; however, we are also competing against all the political candidates who are giving their speeches in the local areas.

- Please pray for people to come and hear the Word that is true and gives life rather than the persuasive political talk which leads to fighting and killing.

- Please pray for Siwi, David, Gabriel, and Stephen as they will be the primary teachers for this outreach. They have been training for such a thing and it is very encouraging to see them doing it now!



### **The Lenz family quarantine (4 down 2 to go)...**

Please pray for our family's health. Currently, Robyn and  $\frac{3}{4}$  of our children are sick. We've been in the village for nearly a year now and scheduled to leave on Wednesday morning to take a much needed and anticipated 2-week family break out of the village: a time to rest, invest in some quality family time, etc.

## There's something about that name...

We want to share an important new change for our organization. This year marks 75 years since New Tribes Mission was first founded and the first missionaries were sent out to reach the unreached among the nations. Because of many important factors, NTM USA has been prayerfully working towards a name change that would assist in the continued efforts of reaching the nations yet today with the ever changing cultural climates around the world. NTM USA's new name encompasses the same vision that New Tribes Mission was founded upon. It is hoped that under this new name our organization will continue to proclaim the message of Christ among all people groups around the globe. New Tribes Mission USA will now be known as **Ethnos360**. 'Ethnos' means 'nations' and '360' represents all 360 degrees around the globe. Among the many facets that had to be taken into consideration was that there are very few 'new tribes' in the world today that have not been touched by some sort of religious influence. This is not to say they've all been reached with the gospel. Rather they've been missionized but not evangelized. Another consideration is that some ethnic groups do not like to be referred to as 'tribes' as this carries a sort of 'redneck' connotation and can be offensive to some, thus keeping our mission from working in some countries. This may be a bit confusing, but this name change only applies for NTM USA. Here in Papua New Guinea, we are still referred to as NTM PNG.
