

## New Opportunities...

In 2012, God blessed the fruits of our team's labor with a small church, but we are concerned about this small church's vitality in a people group of 50,000+. For the last few years our team has been discussing and praying about the possibility of partnering with some other evangelical mission organizations in our area to see the Gospel spread throughout our language group and beyond. In February and May, we met with the leadership of one of these missions to share our concerns about preserving the purity of the Gospel and seeking how we might be able to partner with them to help teach and equip their pastors. We have received positive feedback from these meetings and, most recently, I have been invited to come teach at one of this mission's Bible Colleges where their pastors are trained on July 17 and 18. I have been given 4 hours each morning and have been asked to teach about the Fall of Mankind and The Promise of a Redeemer. *Please pray for me as I prepare my lessons. Pray that this time will go well and will be an inroad for future meaningful partnership. Pray that the current political climate will not keep me from being able to go do this teaching (see below).*
