We have proven the technology to be something that we believe will be a great tool (Go To Meeting) to effectively teach in multiple sites throughout the nation. We have developed the course subjects down to the irreducible minimums to prepare well and to fit it into two years. We are also incorporating a multicultural/local strategy so that people can be taught at a location near where they live at a minimal cost. We also have most of our national teachers lined up for the first year of teaching and are drawing from people with a wealth of experience. When we (our team) first started this effort, we thought it would be too big to do both Spanish and English from the very beginning. But we (Kevin and Lisa) being the primary part of our team focused on the Hispanic community felt burdened by not being able to participate at that level from the beginning. Between those

beginning days and now, we along with our team have decided to do everything possible to start this training in two languages. We are now in the process of looking for a translator to go from English to Spanish, simultaneously in our live webinar. How is that for asking for big things? We remember that we are asking this from the One who created all things with only a word. Please be praying with us in this process.

Kristine has moved to Tucson AZ, and is working as a nurse with Visiting Angels, and liking that job but is still in her 90 day trial/training period.
