

Life and Ministry are going very well here in Aurora, CO. We are constantly finding opportunities for discipleship in Spanish and really loving it. Just a few weeks ago we started teaching a group of young people from our church with a mix of Spanish and English. We are looking forward to getting to know them, and having an influence in their lives for godliness. Please be praying for our interaction with them and that God would give us insight into their world and to know how to help them with interaction with the onslaught of philosophies of the world.

A couple weeks ago, we started meeting with a couple from Peru. He is a brand new believer and she has known the Lord for many years. They started seeking help for their marriage, and He came to know Jesus in that process and is now very interested in getting to know God better. The focus of our time has gone away from being exclusively on marriage towards getting to know God personally. He has already expressed that when that became the focus, it also became the grounds for a good relationship with his wife. We have been meeting with them as a couple but would really love to form a small group. Pray for God's timing for including others in this fellowship.

Our ministry team presses on with our online training of church planter/leaders. It is going very well and people are excited to be able to receive this live training and interaction without having to enroll in a formal institution. We are just into our first year and are looking forward to what God is going to do with this. On the 5th of April we broadcast the subjects of prayer and spiritual warfare. The two men that taught on these subjects were so down to earth, but also intense and convicting. These sessions are presented live, but we also have them recorded. In the coming months, there are a couple things on the horizon. A coworker and I are planning to travel a bit to make more contacts in the Hispanic community to promote our training program among the Spanish/English community. We really believe this will be a great tool to prepare people for ministry. After trying to do this training in two languages simultaneously and not finding it to work well, we are praying about how and when to do a parallel training in Spanish.

Also, the pastor of the church that we attend is working to organize a group of pastors to work together in ministry. He has asked me to be involved with them in teaching and building unity in that group. I am excited to get to know these pastors, build relationships with them, and see how the Lord would use this among Spanish speaking believers. Please pray for God's leading and for all the details to come together.

We have a bit of sad news on the family side. We wrote before that our son Michael was engaged to be married. Unfortunately that is ended and they have broken up. Michael is on the mend, but please do pray for him.
