It is exciting to see trainees that we have discipled and invested time with excelling and blessing the team where they are involved as flight personnel overseas.



The Cessna 206 trainer was in the shop for repairs this semester but it is finally finished and I am completing the paperwork. Also, the trainee, that I assigned to our R66 2000 inspection project is wrapping it up with the other trainees and will soon depart as they travel and raise support before heading abroad. I am, also, helping to install an HF radio into the new Indonesian R66 helicopter. Praise the Lord with us that we received the Field Approval 337 from the FAA, that alone is a huge milestone! Please pray for permission from the Indonesian government to import the R66 helicopter. So much paperwork and bureaucracy involved! There is a great need for aviation in that region! As soon as we get the permission we will disassemble and ship the helicopter in a container.

Where we served as a missionary pilot family in Venezuela and the tribe that my wife, Kim, grew up in have just received solar powered radios with solar panels to be able to charge them. This Spring, Kim and I hosted long time co-workers, a faithful missionary couple who are involved in making these podcasts possible. They just finished recording the teaching of the book of Colossians in the peoples' heart language which is being broadcast from another country into Venezuela. This specific people group are thrilled to hear the teaching, listening to it with their pre-tuned solar radios!! Lately though, it seems they are experiencing inexplicable problems. We would appreciate prayer for the radio station to be back on the air.
