We were able to visit all of our workers in country and meet with them as teams and individuals and it was a good time of encouragement and strategy. Some teams are in the thick of translation and teaching, really lifting up certain people who are hearing truth and trusting their hearts will be opened. Other team are just in the midst of moving to the people group they are working with and starting off a new life and context, building new relationships in a whole new language!

A few families are facing visa challenges and we spent a long time working with them and talking about options and how to continue on long term. We're asking for strength and encouragement for each family and worker as they face various challenges and trust the Lord to sustain them!

Next we will be heading to Mexico to teach at Radius and meet with students. We will actually get to see some of our workers who are home now and in CA before going down so we look forward to that and meeting new potential workers.

We appreciate prayer for strength and health, as we both came back sick from Asia and as we head down to teach and meet students.
