



IBC PreK MOMS During COVID-19

We're excited to resume PreK MOMS this Tuesday, October 27th!

Please read the expectations and guidelines below regarding meeting together during COVID-19.

MASKS

Masks will **not** be required for MOMS leadership, staff, childcare workers, MOMS members, and children. You and your child/children are welcome to wear a mask to our meetings, and we ask that everyone be respectful of each other's particular practice.

TEMPERATURES

We ask that you check temperatures at home so the check-in and drop-off process runs smoothly. In the case that you're unable to check your and/or your child's/childrens' temperatures at home, please see Pam Wickman at the check-in desk upon arrival and she will take temperatures. Temperatures of all who attend MOMS must be at or below 100.3°F.

HEALTH PRECAUTIONS

If you, your child/children, or another person in your immediate household have had contact within the last 14 days of someone diagnosed with COVID-19, please stay home. Additionally, if you, your child/children, or another person in your immediate household are unhealthy, we ask that you please stay home.

Unhealthy symptoms include:

- fever (temperature at or above 100.4°F)
- cough
- shortness of breath
- sore throat
- chills
- loss of taste/smell
- runny nose (yellow/green)
- diarrhea
- vomiting
- other common cold symptoms
- other flu symptoms

CHILDCARE

We will have healthy, symptom-free childcare workers and will admit only healthy children to our nursery and classrooms. Childcare workers and children checked into the nursery or classrooms will be required to have their temperatures checked prior to admittance (preferably at home). Childrens' temperatures must be at or below 100.3°F in order to be admitted into the nursery and classrooms.
